- Be aware of the concepts and basic principles of contracts and contract law
- Understand and manage commercial risk in a project environment
- Negotiate a project contract with a 3rd party
- Be aware of the concepts and principles of managing the customer / supplier relationship
- Implement and manage project change control

Pre-requisites

A minimum of 6 months experience of working in a project or programme environment is required e.g. as a team member, support function or as project manager. A good understanding of basic project management principles and skills is advantageous.
