

Which PRINCE2® solution is right for you?

This training together with the optional exam based accreditation is available in a number of different formats ranging from classroom based courses to tutor supported e-learning. The purpose of this document is to assist you in choosing the training solution that is right for you.

Tutor lead classroom training or directed remote learning?

Consider whether you want to attend a training course or complete the training remotely by e-learning or self study at your own pace. There are of course advantages and disadvantages to consider with both options.

The classroom based options ensures that the training is completed within a fixed period of time within an interactive environment and full tutor support. All our trainers are both accredited by the APMG and experienced projects managers. Classroom training usually incorporates exams.

The e-learning and self study options allow you to complete the training at your own pace wherever you are based. Distance learning does not mean however, that you are on your own. Provek provides a unique tutor support option ensuring any questions you have are answered usually within 24 hours. When undertaking self study and e-learning options delegates can either take exams as part of a scheduled Provek course or elect to attend an APMG examination centre. When delegates are sitting exams at an APMG public exam centre Provek will provide discounted vouchers that will cover exam fees.

Some of our training solutions combine the self study and e-learning options with an interactive workshop which includes all examinations.

Classroom based options

PRINCE2 Overview for sponsors (0.5 or 1 day) – In-house course only

This high level briefing is designed to provide Project Sponsors and Project Board members with the essential overview of PRINCE2 methodology and their role in the process. It will provide practical advice on when and how to perform an effective senior role within the PRINCE2 methodology and environment

PRINCE2 Overview (1 day) – In-house course only

Tailored to suit the requirements of the organisation, the purpose of this overview is to introduce staff to the structured project management method of PRINCE2. The course covers a wide range of topics and includes practical application by the delegates of some of the techniques and components used in PRINCE2.

PRINCE2 Foundation with exam (3 day)

This course enables delegates to attain the level of competence required to pass the PRINCE2 Foundation Certificate. Pre-course study is a pre-requisite to this event.

PRINCE2 Practitioner workshop with exam (2 day)

This workshop is designed to prepare delegates to take the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam. Delegates will have undertaken previous PRINCE2 Foundation Certificate level training (or equivalent self

study) and achieved a 'pass' at Foundation certificate level. This event usually forms the last 2 days of a 5 day Foundation and Practitioner course but can be held independently as required.

PRINCE2 Foundation & Practitioner (5 day)

This course enables delegates to attain the level of competence required to pass the PRINCE2 Foundation and Practitioner exams. Pre-course study is a pre-requisite to this event. Delegates will sit the Foundation exam at the end of the third day. The fourth day is used as a mentoring revision and review session for the Practitioner examination which takes place on the last day of the course.

PRINCE2 Practitioner Re-Registration workshop (2 day)

This accredited workshop is designed to prepare existing PRINCE2 Practitioners for the PRINCE2 Practitioner Re-Registration exam. Delegates will already hold the PRINCE2 Practitioner qualification and be registered as a PRINCE2 Practitioner with the APMG. The APMG requires all registered PRINCE2 Practitioners to be re-registered every 3-5 years. This workshop will incorporate the one hour Re-Registration exam.

Self Study and e-learning options

PRINCE2 Foundation - Self Study + Remote Support

This self-study course will enable delegates with some previous exposure to PRINCE2 to attain the level of competence required to pass the Foundation Certificate examination. It is workbook based with sample Foundation question papers. Remote tutor support is available with this course.

PRINCE2 Foundation & Practitioner - Self Study + Remote Support + 2-day Workshop

This self study course incorporates a 2 day workshop including Foundation and Practitioner exams. It is workbook based with sample Foundation and Practitioner question papers. Remote tutor support is available with this course. The workshop will commence with the Foundation exam and finish with the Practitioner exam.

PRINCE2 Foundation & Practitioner PASSPORT blended e-learning + 2-day classroom

This combines the PRINCE2 Passport e-learning for Foundation and Practitioner with a 2 day interactive workshop which incorporates Foundation and Practitioner exams. This is similar to the Self study and 2-day workshop (see above) except that the workbook is replaced by our e-learning product.

PRINCE2 Foundation PASSPORT - e-learning

PRINCE2 Passport e-learning for Foundation level training is available on either CD or Online. Remote tutor support is available with this course.

PRINCE2 Practitioner PASSPORT - e-learning

PRINCE2 Passport e-learning for Practitioner level training is available on either CD or Online. Remote tutor support is available with this course.
