

APM PMQ BOK7 Two-Day Revision Course

Qualification overview

This two-day revision course will support delegates in their preparation for the APM Project Management Qualification (PMQ). It is designed for those who have completed a comprehensive self-study course or those who are planning an exam re-take. It is important to stress that this is a revision course and delegates will be expected to have the necessary knowledge before attending.

The workshop is available as a classroom event or in a virtual environment using Zoom software. Other platforms are available for client virtual workshops on request.

What is the APM PMQ?

The APM Project Management Qualification (PMQ), is a knowledge-based qualification developed by APM, the chartered body for the project profession. Candidates will be able to demonstrate an understanding of how these elements interact and how their project fits into their strategic and commercial environment. PMQ is an internationally recognised qualification.

Provek have worked closely with the APM and have played an active role in the creation of this qualification.

Who is it for?

The APM Project Management Qualification is aimed at those wishing to achieve a broad level of project management knowledge sufficient to participate in projects from individual assignments through to large capital projects. Applicants typically have some pre-existing project management knowledge, and it is the ideal next step for anyone holding the APM Project Fundamentals Qualification (PFQ).

Raise your project management to the next level

What is assessed?

The PMQ syllabus assesses breadth of knowledge in all areas of project management and covers knowledge areas, including budgeting and cost management, conflict management, communication, earned value management, leadership, negotiation, procurement, sponsorship and teamwork.

How is it assessed?

There are two examination routes for the qualification:

- A three hour paper where candidates must answer ten from sixteen questions. OR
- For PRINCE2® Registered Practitioners a two hour paper that recognises prior learning. In this paper candidates must answer six from ten questions.

This revision workshop does not include the exam although Provek can arrange to do this on request.

What will this course consist of?

The course is tutor-led with participative exercises including tips/techniques with opportunities to practise answering sample exam questions under time pressure.

The expert trainer will also mark a sample of your completed sample questions during the course and provide you with detailed feedback including indicative scores. This is designed to get you 'exam ready' and build your confidence for the three-hour exam.

Where delivered remotely, the default software platform is Zoom.

What study materials are supplied?

You will receive a pdf copy of The Provek Book, which includes:

- Comprehensive narrative that covers every assessment criteria.
- Multiple sample PMQ exam questions and answers for each learning outcome.
- Guidance, tips and techniques to pass the exam.
- Sample project management templates for use in the workplace.
- APM guidance information.

Course style

The course has been carefully designed to integrate on-screen learning with off-screen learning. The video conferencing capability enables candidates to learn in a dynamic way using a range of video, virtual whiteboards and breakout rooms for small-group exercises. Sessions will be interspersed with breaks for reflection of learning and revision.

The course will have 3 x one-hour breaks each day. During these breaks you will be expected to spend some time completing tutor guided study which will involve answering sample exam questions.

Pre-requisites

It is vital that you come prepared having completed self-study or a classroom course. In addition, you should plan to keep your evening free on day one for evening work.
