

APM Project Management Qualification (PMQ)

Qualification overview

The APM Project Management Qualification (PMQ) is a knowledge-based qualification developed by the Association for Project Management that allows candidates to demonstrate understanding of all elements of project management and how these elements interact and fit into their strategic and commercial environment.

Who is this qualification for?

The APM Project Management Qualification is aimed at those wishing to achieve a broad level of project management knowledge enough to participate in projects from individual assignments to large capital projects.

It is designed to improve the skills of the project management staff to enable them, through good project management practice, to make sound business decisions and thereby helping all projects to succeed.

Learning outcomes

Provek offer a variety of training options providing flexibility to work around work and personal commitments.

Delegates can study online via Provek's award-winning PM Channel, attend our two-day exam preparation workshop following a training course (or online study), or attend one of our public training courses.

Courses also have the option of our 3+3-day modular training, delivered over two weeks and 5 days over 5 consecutive weeks.

Pre-requisites

- Good project management basic skills or attendance on the APM PFQ course plus a minimum of twelve months actual experience of working across a range of project management areas and functions.
- Delegates are required to complete Provek's PMA Lite assessment to help assess readiness and suitability.

Learning outcomes

Course content

The course is presented in 11 learning outcomes comprising of:

- Practice examination questions.
- Example examination answers.
